What is UNITED For the City Missions Week?

UNITED 2024 will lead the community by training students in grades 7-12 to **share** their faith & provide opportunities to **serve** Selma's children and adults through week-long mission projects. Those opportunities include Backyard Bible Clubs and Sports Camps.

Cost per person (7-12th grades)- \$100

- All meals & transportation from Sunday night through Friday
- Lodging for the week at Elkdale Baptist Church with genders separated by buildings and individuals stall shower trailers
- All materials for UNITED ministry sites & Disciplemaking manual
- T-Shirt, and other SWAG!

Camp Pastor(s)– Caleb Winningham is the Pastor of Valley Grande Baptist here in our area. He is excited about motivating students through God's Word to share the reason for our hope!

Charlie Windham is the Music/Youth Pastor at Hillcrest Baptist Church in Maplesville. This will be his 3rd year with the UNITED Family! He enjoys training students to love the Lord and share their story about Him!

Worship Leader– Andrew Morris is coming back to UNITED to lead us in worship! Andrew is a graduate of Samford U. and is one of the Worship Pastors at FBC Trussville. Andrew serves with the Student Ministry and in the Contemporary Worship Service on Sundays. He has a tremendous heart for worship, but when he's not leading worship Andrew loves to write music, and play basketball. Andrew is excited to be a part of the UNITED Family and bring alongside some talented musicians to lead in worship! Welcome back Andrew!

Registration Policy

Church Deposit Due –June 3, 2024.

Each church is required to pay a non-refundable \$150 deposit to ensure that their group is locked into UNITED. This deposit is not an additional cost to your church and will be credited to your ending balance due on July 8. Checks should be made out to ELKDALE BAPTIST CHURCH memo: UNITED and mailed to ELKDALE BAPTIST CHURCH 2221 Elkdale Street Selma, AL 36701. Online payment is available too.

Per Person Deposit & Transportation list Due – June 24, 2024.

There is a \$50 deposit per person registered, including adult chaperones & your initial Transportation list (at bottom of this packet) due to ELKDALE. Here is an example, if you have 20 people registered, you would be required to pay a deposit of \$1,000 (20 people x \$50 by this date. This deposit will go towards each individual's \$100 participation fee. Checks should be made out to ELKDALE BAPTIST CHURCH memo: UNITED and mailed to Elkdale Baptist Church 2221 Elkdale Street Selma, AL 36701.

Our staff will consider the number of people you send in paid deposits as your final number of participants. Therefore, your church will be financially responsible for that number of participants attending UNITED. Participating churches will be locked into their number of spots for UNITED as of the time we receive their deposit, but they can make changes within their group up until *Monday July 8, 2024*.

Final Payment, Updated Transportation List & Overall Church Participation List Due Monday July 8, 2024.

1. Final payment is due for each church's remaining balance.
 - a. A church's participation will only be considered finalized after we have received the final payment for their remaining balance.
2. Finalized Overall Church Participation Form Due
 - a. This is the listing of each person attending, including adult chaperones, and their ministry track choices.
 - b. The Overall Church Participation Form will be available on our website for you to download.
 - c. It should be completed and emailed to Ashley.Potvin@elkdale.org no later than July 8, 2024.

WHAT TO BRING TO UNITED

- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Sleeping Bag and/or Air Mattress (you will be on the floor for a week, so an air mattress may feel better. However, if you bring an air mattress it needs to be a twin size for only one person to sleep on.)
- Towels, wash cloths, pillows, and blankets (linens if bringing an air mattress)
- Toiletries such as toothbrush, shampoo, soap, **shower shoes***, etc.
There will be separate shower trailers on site for guys and girls.
- **IMPORTANT** - Closed toe, closed heel shoes for all missions sites and any outdoor activities.
- **IMPORTANT** - Sun protection.

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO UNITED

- **DO NOT BRING** alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon or tool including pocket knives.
- **DO NOT BRING** items that may be used for pranks such as water balloons, shaving cream, silly string, etc. Pranks are not allowed at camp. Your church will be charged for any damages or issues related to clean up.

ELECTRONICS & PHONE POLICY

The decision for electronics & cell phone usage is in the hands of the Student Pastor/Group Leader of each church. During limited downtime & before lights out, there will be time to play video games in both of the separate housing buildings & common rooms. Throughout the week, UNITED will have some elements that allow participants to join in via social media (i.e. Instagram, Facebook, etc.). However, unless instructed by staff, students with cell phones are **not** allowed to have them out or in use during programming elements: Morning Celebration, Bible Study, Worship, and while at Ministry Sites. Ringers should be turned to silent or vibrate during these specific times. UNITED staff will not be responsible for any lost or damaged electronics/phones.

DAMAGES

Please be aware that your group is personally responsible for damages to any facilities including but not limited to the rooms your group occupies.

DRESS CODE

Please ask your students **NOT** to pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions, immorality or situations
- Is sleeveless, has spaghetti/small straps, or an open back, except for sleepwear. This includes tank tops.
- Is excessively short or tight fitting.

Please ask your students to:

- Wear modest shorts (when hands are extended to the back or the front, fingertips must touch fabric).
- Wear closed-toe and closed heel shoes while at ministry sites.
- Wear modest shorts, pants, jeans, or dresses for worship. Dresses with spaghetti or small straps, open backs, and excessively short lengths are unacceptable (when hands are extended to the back or front, finger tips must touch fabric).
- Not dress in a way that calls attention to their underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistband, etc.) or wear pants or shorts with lettering on the bottom.
- Bring a dark t-shirt in case of being around water games (mostly Children's Ministry).
- Adult leaders have the responsibility of modeling and monitoring their group to ensure students are dressing appropriately.
- **FRIDAY FUN DAY SWIM clothes: 1-piece swimsuit/ tankini or Dark t-shirt over tops. No speedoes or loose fitting bathing suits (there will be tubing at high speeds).**

- 1) **Chaperones for students** - We will separate same-church students (based on students choosing their missions sites and having at least 2 students from each church, as best we can) and we ask that the chaperones do the same and choose the sites where God has gifted them. Adults can serve and lead alongside of students...not necessarily with their own church kids but with the UNITED ministry sites.
We ask that ALL WEEK each church have at least 1 adult male for 6 boys and 1 adult female for 6 girls.
Each site will have 1 adult Site leader, at least 2 adult chaperones (one, possibly being a driver), and 8-10 students in 7-12th grades. All adults age 19+ will require State & National background checks to work with minors in any capacity during this week.
- 2) **Sponsor and serve on a breakfast, lunch or dinner team.**
Lunch sponsors: Wide Open for your church to plug in!
Dinner sponsors: (2023) Sunday-CSUMC; Monday- FBC Selma; Tuesday- Cornerstone Pres; Wednesday-Elkdale. Contact Sylvia Odom 412-2338 to schedule your church or Sunday School to host a meal.
- 3) **Serve as hall monitors** during the day when students return from missions sites on Elkdale Campus.
- 4) **Extra adults can serve on all mission sites.** We would ask that the adult stay at 1 mission site ALL WEEK to build Christ-like loving relationships with the families of the community that attend and with our students. State & National background checks are required for adults.
- 5) **We welcome all adults and students to come and worship with us at night.** Worship geared towards the students will be held 7:30pm-9:00pm every night in the Elkdale Sanctuary. The Bible will be preached passionately & the hearers will be challenged to become doers of God's Word.
